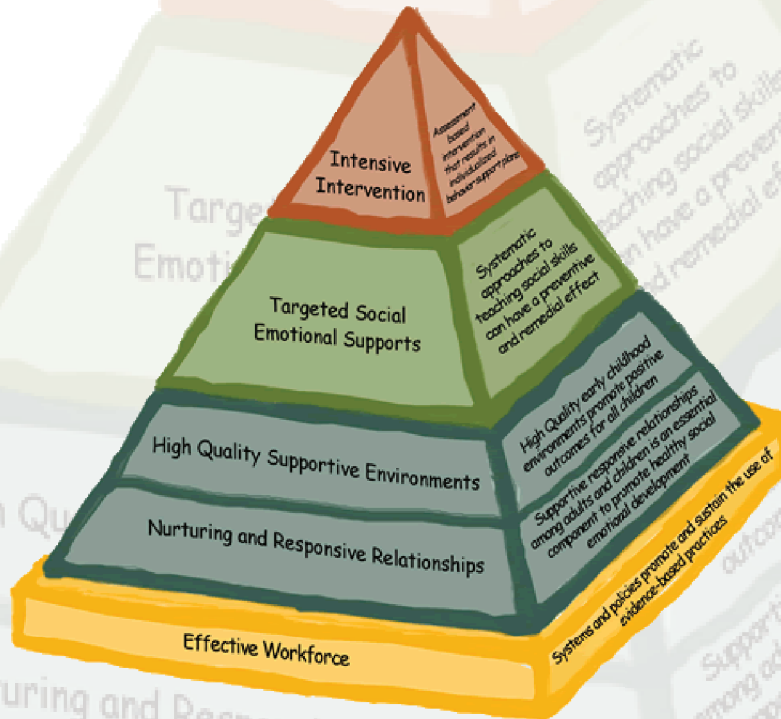


Social Emotional Development as a Foundation for School & Life Success
